

## Thema national extensions August 2016

This is the consolidated list of additions and updates for the August 2016 update of the *Thema* national extensions, as ratified by the *Thema* international steering committee. They concern the additions of a number of geographical qualifiers for region, province and municipality subdivisions of China.

Implementors should note the reordering of the four pre-existing codes 1FPCH to 1FPCW, and the fact that Tibet (1FPCT) is now treated as a 'child category' of the Southwest China region (1FPC-CN-H) rather than as a child of China itself (1FPC). For compatibility reasons, its code does not change, so the meaning of existing data is not altered. This change was necessary to align the Chinese national extensions with ISO 3166-2:CN and with other standards used within China.
